A voucher requesting the funds for the next phase of work at Mt. Ida was processed on March 17, 2024 by Commander Swartwout and submitted to the City of Troy. Gravestone/Monument conservation work to be performed by Mr. Joe Ferrannini of Grave Stone Matters will start on or about May 1 and will continue for 30 days. This work will focus on New Mt. Ida Cemetery on Pinewoods Avenue in Troy.

In addition, Alysia Hamilton has registered New Mt. Ida with the City as a site for Earth Day activities. Cleanup will occur on Saturday, April 27 from 9 AM to 12 PM. The Phi Sigma Kappa Tetarton Chapter at RPI will be assisting and Camp members are strongly encouraged to join in the efforts.

A report on the activities performed at the Mt. Ida Cemeteries in 2023 was submitted by Cameron Smith, project manager, and Brother David Dziewulski PCC, program manager for Willard Camp, to Troy Deputy Mayor Seamus Donnelly. The report outlined 23 tasks that were successfully completed and acknowledged the many volunteers who helped the project.
